## **Requirements and Expectations for Sacramental Preparation**

The Sacramental Preparation Program is designed to assist parents in learning more about the Catholic faith and reflecting on the role the Catholic Church plays in their lives in sharing their faith with their children. As such, this program is an opportunity to strengthen the faith of the parents at a critical time in the spiritual lives of their children.

**Both children and parents need to recognize that a person does not receive the sacraments just because they have reached a certain age or because they are in a certain grade. Rather, reception of the sacraments requires that both the children and the parents have taken the necessary steps to prepare for the celebration of the sacraments.**

### **Reconciliation**

Children and the parents of children wishing to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation are **required** to attend the Reconciliation Formation Retreats on:

**Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup> from 9-11:30am and**

**Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> from 9-11:30am.**
